What is ECVET?

ECVET is the European Credit transfer System for Vocational Education and Training which aims to achieve

- the transfer and recognition of individuals' learning outcomes,
- a compatibility between the different vocational education and training (VET) systems and qualifications in Europe and thereby
- supports mobility of European citizens, offering complementary documents.

And why does it want to go business?

In order to become effective, the transfer and recognition of individuals' learning outcomes and the compatibility of different systems and qualifications need to satisfy labour market demands.

Training course for human resource staff

A two day training course for human resource staff will be designed, offering

- the chance for a face to face programme, including discussions about instruments, cases and possible solutions,
